What is Construction Connections?

Construction Connections is a nine week Pre-Apprenticeship Training Program designed to prepare participants for a career in the construction industry. The program is a collaboration between the Urban League of Greater Cincinnati and Allied Construction Industries and focuses on soft skill development as well as technical instruction. Upon completion of the 193 hour program, each student will be equipped with:

- National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Core Curriculum Certification
- Registration into NCCER's National Registry Occupational Safety & Health Administration 10-Hour Certification (OSHA 10)
- A New Basic Set of Hand Tools and Protective Equipment Including a Hard Hat and Steel Toe Boots
- 8 Credit Hours from Cincinnati State Technical and Community College
