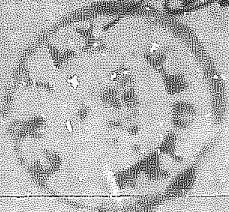

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The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under the General Corporation Act of Ohio, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of said corporation shall be The Urban League of Greater Cincinnati, Incorporated.

SECOND: The place in this State where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is Cincinnati, Hamilton County.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which said corporation is formed are: To plan for, encourage, assist and engage in the improvement of economic, industrial, social and cultural conditions of the Negro population; to discover community needs affecting Negroes and to interest individuals and groups in undertaking to meet such needs; to coordinate and cooperate with existing agencies and organizations to further these aims; to promote the improvement of race relations and to further cooperation of all groups in behalf of the common welfare.
